Please observe the size restrictions for club (and other) competitions. 12" x 16" (30 x 40cm), including the matt, is the largest size for our club competition. Entries larger than this may be rejected as they do not fit in the postage box and are also difficult to scan for digital projection.

Also, watch the thickness of your matted entries. 5mm is the maximum or once again the postage box may not fit all entries.

Try to put a backing on your matted prints ... this will help to protect them from damage.
