RECENT CLUB OUTINGS:

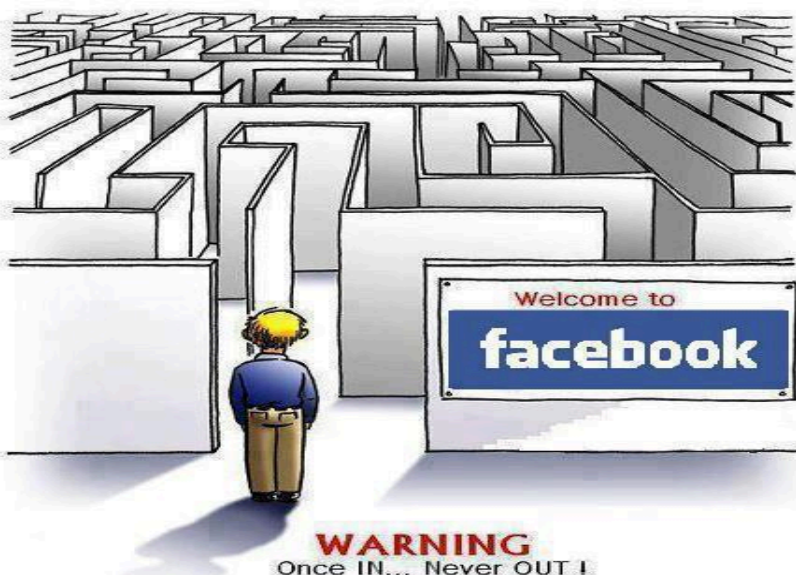


Rain sent the Beatles [bands] indoors which provided a real challenge for the **few** members who ventured to Dean Street with camera in hand.
