The range covers:

- Lens Bags from the smallest to the largest bags

- Lens Warmers (with window) made to order to suit the size lens
- Filter/Ring Adapter Pouch with 4, 6 or 8 pockets. Made of soft fabric to avoid scratching. Folds into a neat pouch for ease of transporting.
- Rain Covers to protect the camera during wet conditions. Comes with carry bag to match
- Dust Covers to protect the camera in dusty conditions. Comes with carry bag to match
- Stabiliser Pillows 3 shapes of rectangle, square or round. To stabilise the camera when a tripod is not available.
- Strap Covers a sleeve to encase the existing strap making it more comfortable around the neck during long shoots
