

What was/is your profession?

I was an Environmental Health and Building Surveyor at Wagga Wagga, Albury City and Greater Hume Shire Councils. I also taught Architecture Design and Building subjects at Albury and Wodonga TAFE's.

What was it that encouraged you to join the WACC?

Maree Mills encouraged me to join WACC while I was attending a photographic course at Albury TAFE. She was right when she said I could gain a lot of photography knowledge at the camera club particularly in portrait and landscapes.

What camera/lens do you use?

My first camera was a Kodak Brownie Box. I now mainly use a Canon 80D camera with lenses from 100mm Macro, 35mm Prime, 10-22mm, 24-105mm, and 70-200 Zooms. I also have three Lumix Panasonic Compacts and two (from the dark side) Nikon Compacts!!! maybe that's why I still have trouble taking worthwhile photos.

CREATORS PHOTOGRAPHY FESTIVAL 2019

WACC member Paul Temple, in conjunction with Creators Art Space, is convening a Photography Festival to celebrate the **180th anniversary of the birth of photography.**



The festival will incorporate three exhibitions and a number of practical workshops over a period of 7 weeks from **18th September until 4th November.**

The middle exhibition will consist of photographs produced using Alternative / Traditional photographic processes.

This will be from 2nd - 20th October and will feature photographers Rob Elliot, Rachel Pringle, Eric Saros and Paul Temple.

Expressions of interest are being sought for the 2 weeks before the middle exhibition, 18th - 29th September and the two weeks following, 23rd October - 4th November. These can consist of digital images, there are no restrictions.

The exhibitions can be solo or groups of participants.

For two weeks the gallery hire is \$200. Add to that some flyers, invites etc and total cost should be around \$300.
