

Preparing EDI Images - with Photoshop for WACC Competitions



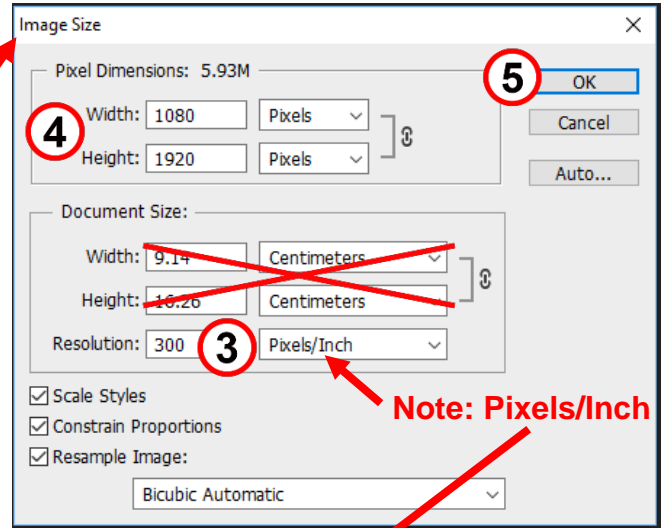
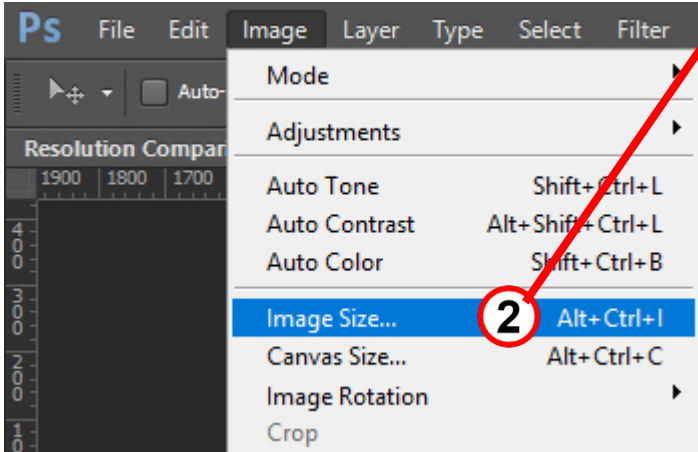
Before you start –

Remember your best to be working on a **copy NOT your original.**

...So you have finished working on your image and **saved** it as a PSD, TIFF or JPEG etc.

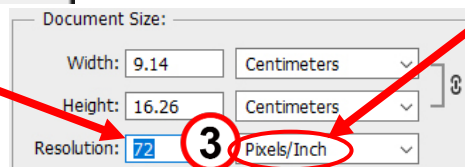
1. Crop the image

2. Select *Image Size* from the *Image* menu



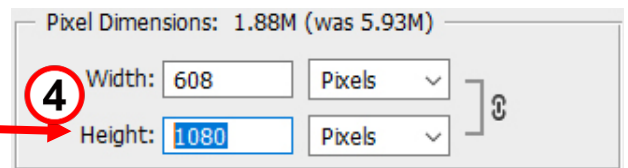
3. Enter 72 in the Resolution box

Ensure you have **Pixels/Inch** selected



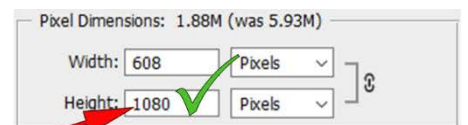
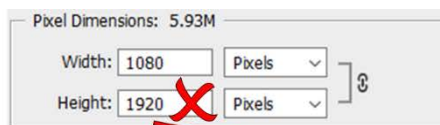
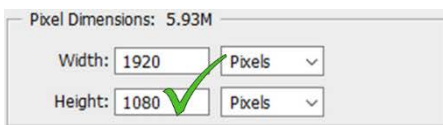
4. Resize the image... carefully. Pixel Dimensions

For **Portrait** orientation
Height - Enter **1080**



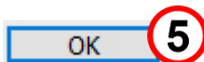
For **Landscape** orientation

Width - Enter **1920**, **CHECK** that the height is less than **1080** if not Enter **1080** for **Height** and leave the **Width** as is.



X Height needs to be 1080 or less, correct by entering a height of 1080

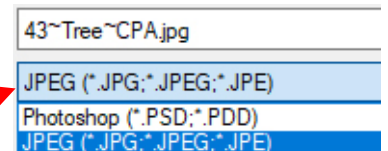
5. Press **OK**



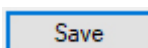
6. Now select **Save As** from the **File** menu and save as **jpg** file.

For **WACC**: Image Title = **Member No.~Title~Competition** e.g. **43~Tree~CP.jpg**

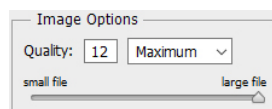

Ensure **Quality** is **Maximum**



and **Press OK**
