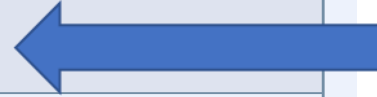

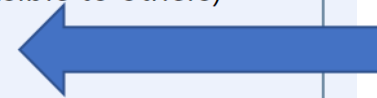



Drag and drop your existing images into your desired sequence by grabbing the title bar above an image. You cannot drag and drop new images onto this page and must use the buttons instead.



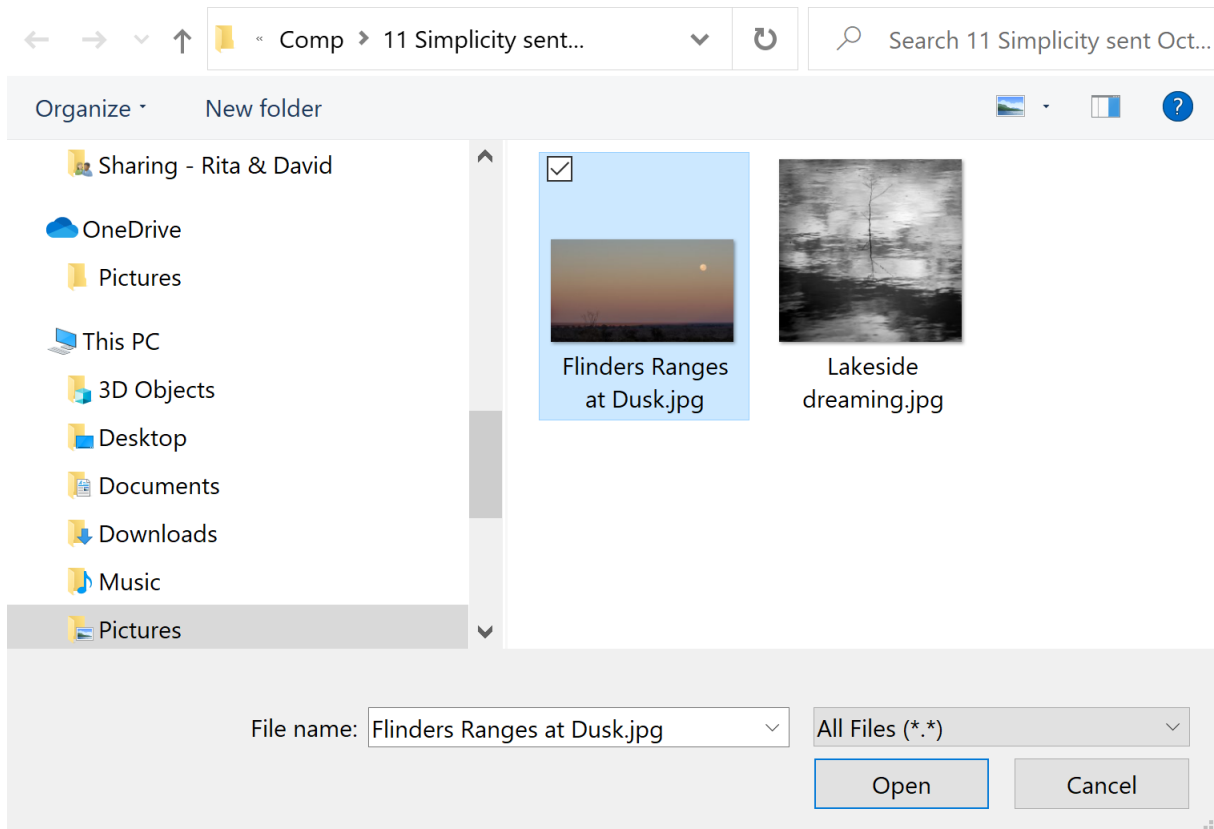
Click Upload Images into this Gallery to enter images from your computer files



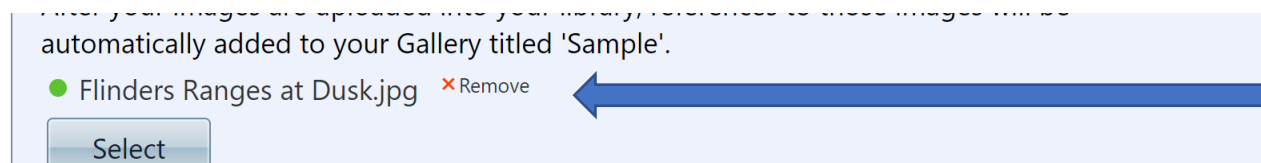
After your images are uploaded into your library, references to those images will be automatically added to your Gallery titled 'Sample'.

Select Return to Gallery without adding images to the gallery Save Images and Proceed to Edit Page

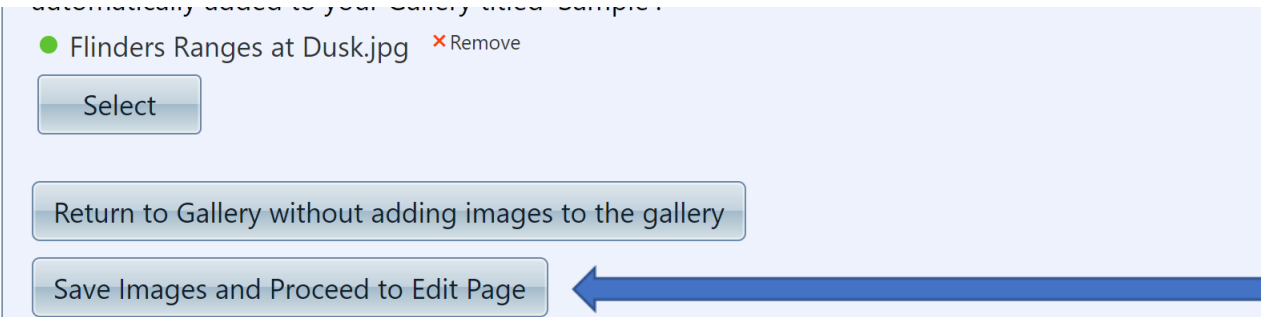
Click Select to open your files

Author's image id: This is a field for the author's use only to help identify the image within the author's collection.

If a Sequence Name is present, your image will be placed into an Image Sequence. Clear the name or set the Image Number to zero to remove the image from an Image Sequence. Each image within an Image Sequence must be numbered sequentially.

The titles for images in a sequence will be altered automatically when viewed to include the sequence number, but NOT the name of the sequence. You can control where the sequence number is inserted into a title by coding "[]" or "[2 of 3]" into your title. The actual numbers will be inserted in that location instead of at the end of the title.

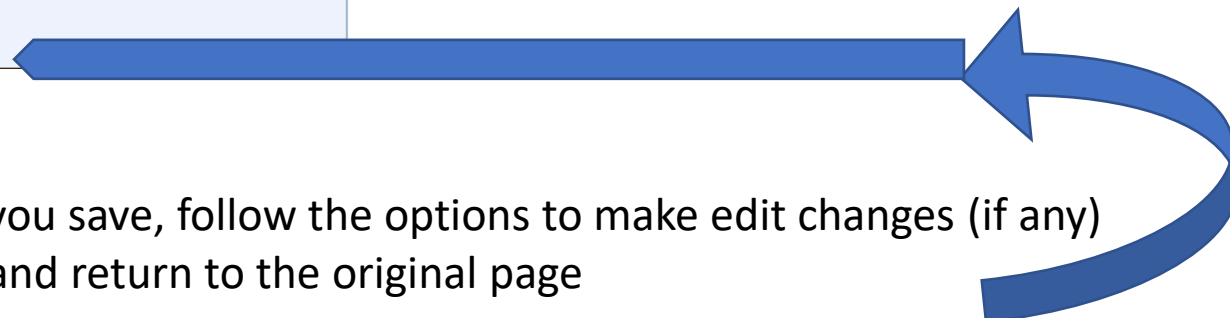

Save any changes and return to the original page


You get a chance to edit before you save, follow the options to make edit changes (if any)
