


Worthwhile efforts to capture the action

Like most of us, you've probably had that time when you see something you know is a unique photographic opportunity, but you are without your camera gear to best capture it. Well, that's what Yvonne experienced, but fortunately she still managed to make the most of the situation and create this great shot below. Yvonne had just arrived in Paris for the beginning of their 7 week holiday and her Olympus camera 'cooked itself' so was sent home early to Foto Supplies! They were staying in the Basque region (South west France, near the Spain border) with the parents of their French exchange student who was very keen to have them experience some local cultural events. With some hesitation on Yvonne's behalf, they all headed off to attend a bull fighting event being held in Dax. Yvonne felt she would be more comfortable watching the action through a lens, so borrowed a camera only to find she was unable to read the settings as they were in French! Finding Automatic Sport Mode she started shooting and just hoped for the best. Fortunately, the Panasonic DMZFZ150 was also set on 'burst', meaning it was continuously shooting when the shutter button was pressed. During software processing four images were selected from Lightroom and moved across to be edited as Layers in Photoshop. The layers were autoaligned and blended. Other detailed adjustments were then made using masking, selection brushes and 'Opacity' blending mode. Final editing was done back in Lightroom increasing saturation with the focus on the red, noise reduction and finally a slight vignette. Yvonne would be happy to explain any further editing details.



SEASONS IN THE REGION

DETAILS

- Entry: Free

- **Judges**: Alice Schnelle and the staff (all non-photographers)
- Photo size: At least 46cm on the longest edge but preferably bigger
- **Frame**: Black or White (preferably black and not obviously second hand)
- Matt: A must, but whatever colour suites the photo
- Selection of Photos: Members need to send a maximum of 4 "WACC competition" sized digital files with WACC member number, photo title and email address to yvonnewaters@ozemail.com.au before **10**th August.
- I will acknowledge all sent emails. 1 photo per member will be selected, subject to suitability, unless there are not enough entries. Entrants will be notified by the 17th August which photo has been selected. This will leave 2 weeks for framing if not already in a frame.
- **Sales**: There will be no commission but all sales will need to be made through the photographer.
